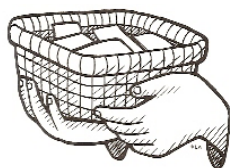

Please welcome Father Lively this weekend. He is just back from the Holy Land, so if you have any questions, catch him after Mass.

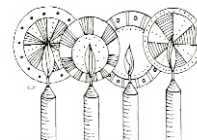
